The Dutchess County MS4 Coordination Committee is pleased to announce a billboard contest open to all High School students within Dutchess County.

What is an MS4? MS4 = Municipal Separate Storm Sewer Systems

In the 1970's the newly created EPA (Environmental Protection Agency) produced the Clean Water Act, which focuses on improving our environment and waterways. Over the last 4 decades, this has resulted in the EPA passing along regulations to States to enact and enforce protective measures to continue that mission. In New York, it is the NYSDEC (New York State Department of Environmental Conservation) who has passed those requirements down to designated Towns, Villages, Cities, Counties, State Agencies and School Districts. In Dutchess County, 14 Municipalities (Towns, Villages, and County) have worked together to form the Dutchess County MS4 Coordination Committee. The goal of this Committee is to combine resources for things like public outreach and education... which is why we are sponsoring a billboard campaign! One of our main goals is to make people think of rain water... what it washes away... what it takes away... and where it goes and dumps into our streams, creeks, rivers and the ocean... This year's campaign is focused specifically on what we can all do to help keep our waterbodies clean.

The following number of entries will be accepted per school as follows:

- Schools with 1,000 students or less can submit 4 entries;
- Schools with 1,000 to 2,000 students can submit 5 entries;
- Schools with 2,000 plus students can submit 6 entries.

Top school entries are to be submitted by April 30, 2020 to me, the MS4 Committee representative, or to Dutchess County Soil & Water located at 2715 Rt 44 in Millbrook. Please contact me or DC Soil & Water (845-677-8011 ext 3) to arrange pick up, if necessary.

The Dutchess County MS4 will announce three prize winners by June 12, 2020:

- 1st Prize = \$500 + A Billboard in the County with the winner & School District recognized
- 2nd Prize = \$300
- 3rd Prize = \$100
- The teacher of the first prize winner will also receive \$100
- All three prize winners will be utilized by the Dutchess County MS4 Committee for education and outreach. MS4 Municipalities may utilize their regional submissions, in addition to the top three prize winners, for localized education and outreach.

Media & size: Watercolors, oil or acrylic paintings, drawings, photographs or computer painted art. All entries must be submitted digitally and on 10.5 in x 22.75 in paper. All entries must be able to be converted to a minimum of a 300 dpi .pdf. All paper submissions must have name & School on the back.

Awards: County selected student winners will be awarded \$500 for first prize; \$300 for second prize; \$100 for third prize. The Teacher of the first prize winner will also receive a prize of \$100. County selected student winners will be announced by June 12, 2020.

Exhibition: The first prize County selected student winner agrees to have their artwork utilized as a billboard with their name and school recognized. Second & third prize winners agree to have their artwork utilized for education and outreach with their name and school recognized. All school's entries agree to allow each municipality to utilize their artwork for local education and outreach with their name and School recognized.
